


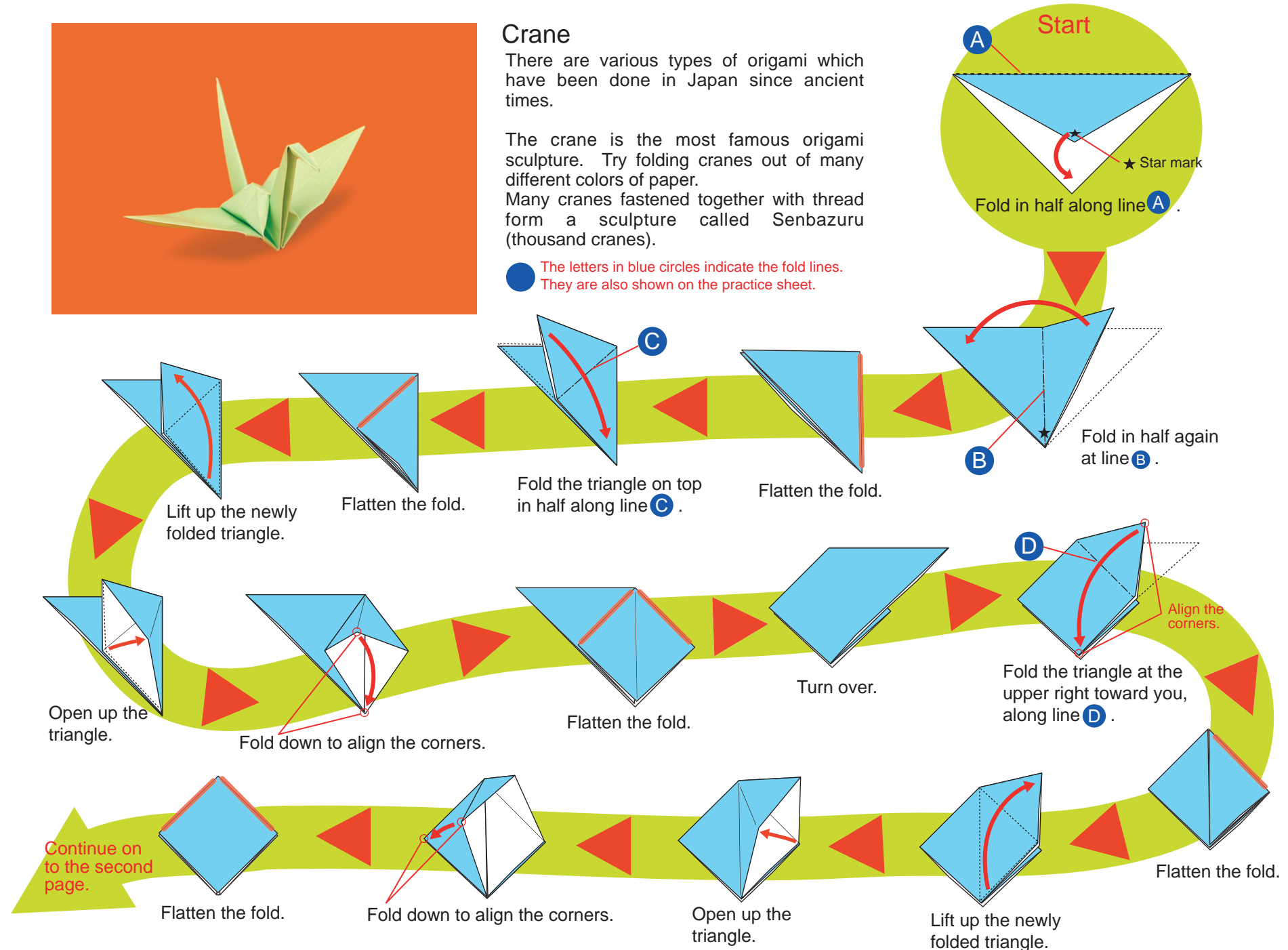


## Crane

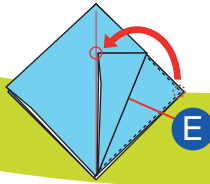
There are various types of origami which have been done in Japan since ancient times.

The crane is the most famous origami sculpture. Try folding cranes out of many different colors of paper. Many cranes fastened together with thread form a sculpture called Senbazuru (thousand cranes).

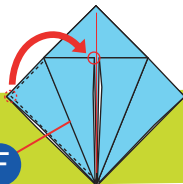
 The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.



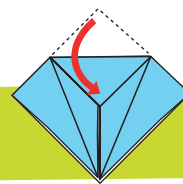

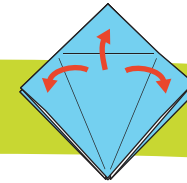
Fold in the right side  
along line **E**, so that  
the right edge is aligned  
with the center line.



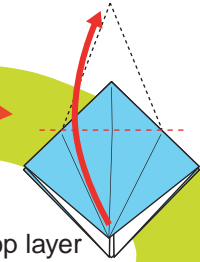
Fold in the left side  
along line **F**, so that  
the left edge is aligned  
with the center line.



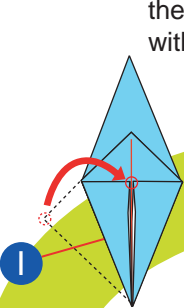
Fold the top triangle  
forward along line **G**.



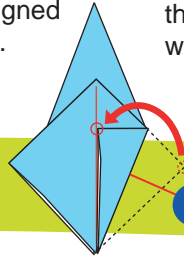
Unfold the last  
three folds.



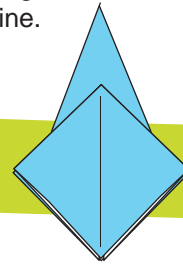
Lift the top layer  
of paper upward.



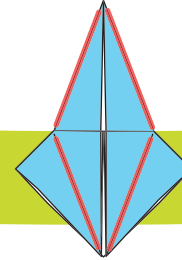
Fold in the left side  
along line **I**, so that  
the left edge is aligned  
with the center line.



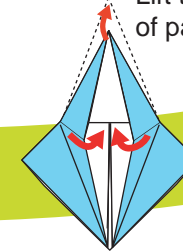
Fold in the right side  
along line **H**, so that  
the right edge is aligned  
with the center line.



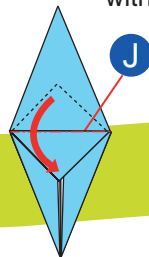
Turn over.



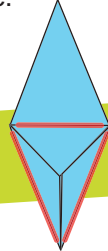
Flatten the fold.



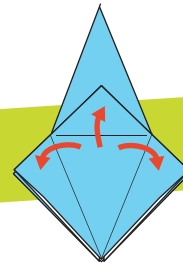
Pulling the upper corner  
over and back, fold both  
sides inward to the center.



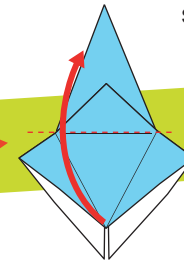
Fold the top triangle  
forward along line **J**.



Flatten the fold.



Unfold the last  
three folds.



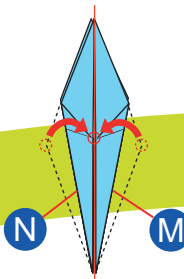
Lift the top layer  
of paper upward.



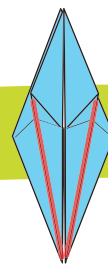
Pulling the upper corner  
over and back, fold both  
sides inward to the center.



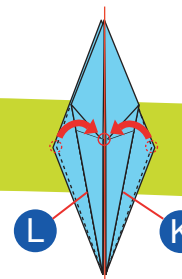
Flatten  
the fold.



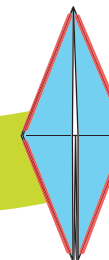
Turn over, and then fold in  
the right and left sides along  
lines **M** and **N**, so that  
the right and left edges are  
aligned with the center line.



Flatten the fold.



Fold in the right and left sides  
along lines **K** and **L**, so that  
the right and left edges are  
aligned with the center line.



Flatten the fold.
