



Duck [A4 size 3pages]


There are various types of origami which have been done in Japan since ancient times.

This pattern lets you fold a cute duck, complete with beak and wings.


● The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.




Fold along line C, so that the right corner of the paper also lines up with the center crease.




Fold along line B, so that the left corner of the paper lines up with the center crease.




Unfold the paper and flatten.



Fold along line D, so that the left corner of the paper lines up with the center crease.





Fold along line E, so that the right corner of the paper also lines up with the center crease.



Turn over.

Continue on to the second page.
